# **ENTRY FORMS, RULES AND CLOSING DATES**

#### **FORMS**

- 1. All entries must be made on the **CURRENT PRESCRIBED FORM DATED 2021** or a clear photocopy thereof.
- Entry forms must list only the names of the candidates entered for the class indicated on the form. <u>A separate form</u> must be submitted for each CLASS. (e.g. LPO 3)
- Please print clearly or submit a typed list for correct spelling on certificates.
- **4.** Entries can be delivered to 12 Mafeking Road, Bergyliet and placed in the Eisteddfod Box provided.
- **5.** Entries may be posted by Courier or Postnet (Contact Convenor for details)

#### **RULES**

- Candidates <u>may enter as many entries as they wish in any</u> section.
- **7.** A work previously entered may not be submitted again in another year.
- 8. All works must be original and certified by a teacher or parent.
- **9.** Literature must be clearly written or typed.
- **10.** Extra marks will be given for interpretation of the topics.
- 11. Items may in entered in English, Afrikaans or French.
- 12. Your writing must have a label attached on the front stating the class, topic, name of entrant and grade at school. All work MUST be labelled with name of student, grade, class and NAME OF SCHOOL and affixed to the front of the work. See example of label below:

#### **ADJUDICATORS:**

- Adjudicators are appointed by the convenor, who shall have the power to terminate the appointment and appoint another adjudicator should serious legitimate complaints be received.
- 2. No adjudicators may adjudicate the work of a close family member or their own pupils.
- Adjudicators are obliged to give percentages to all Honours and Diploma candidates. These percentages may not be disclosed to entrants but will be known only to the committee for the purpose of making special awards.
- 4. PLEASE NOTE: Should any infringement of the rules be detected, it can be reported to the Convenor or Chairperson.
- 5. Contravention of the rules could lead to disqualification.
